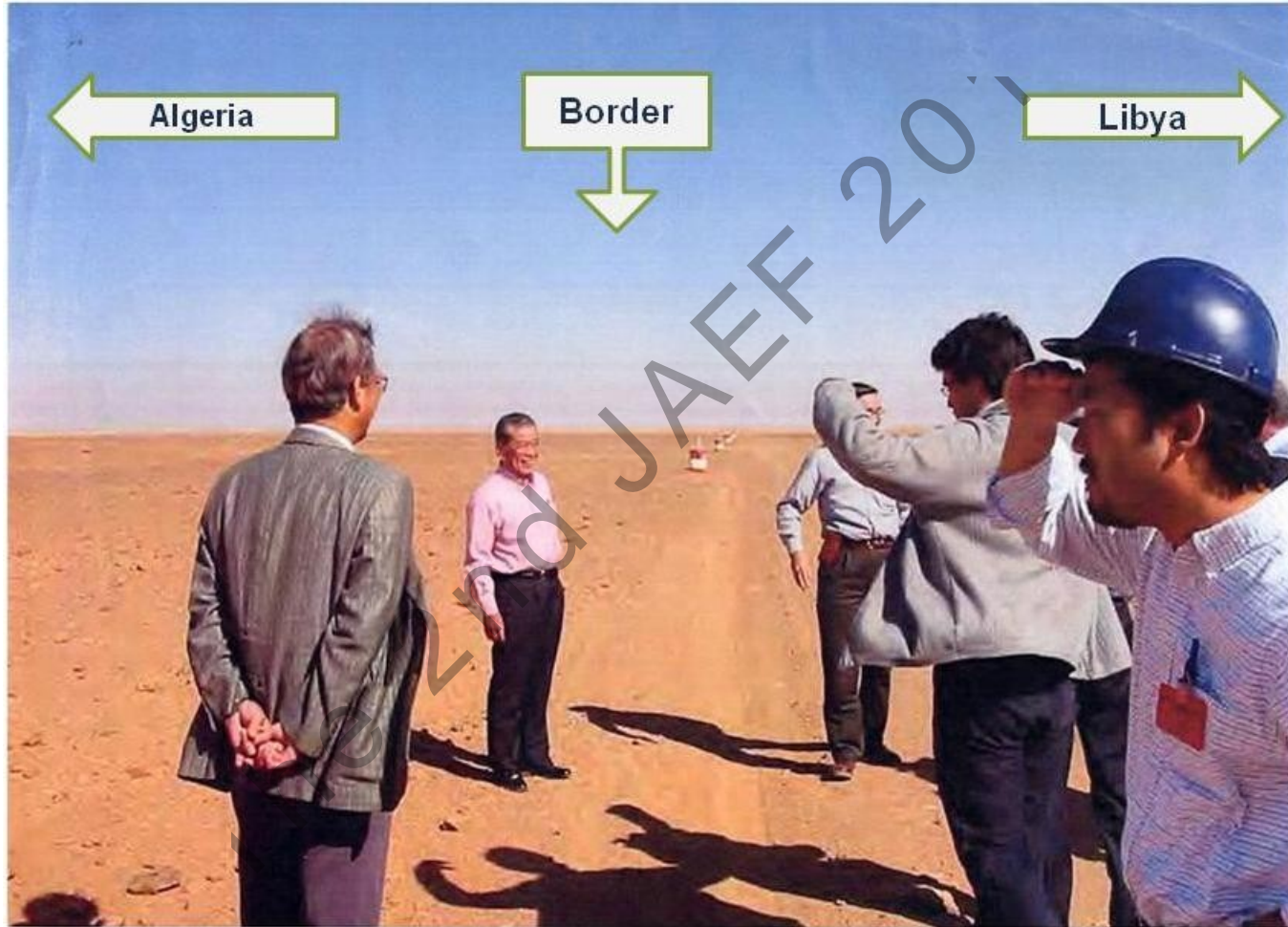

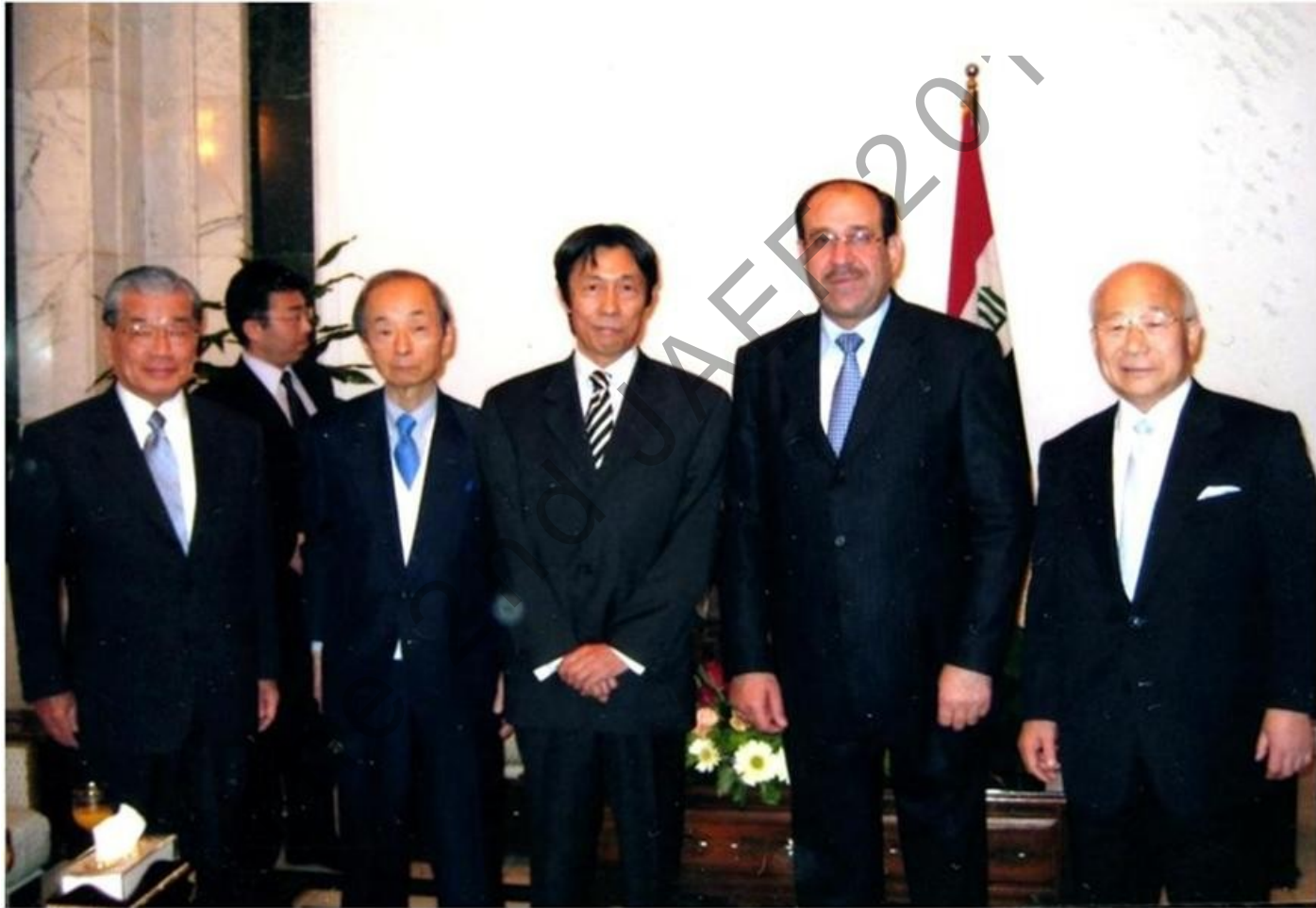

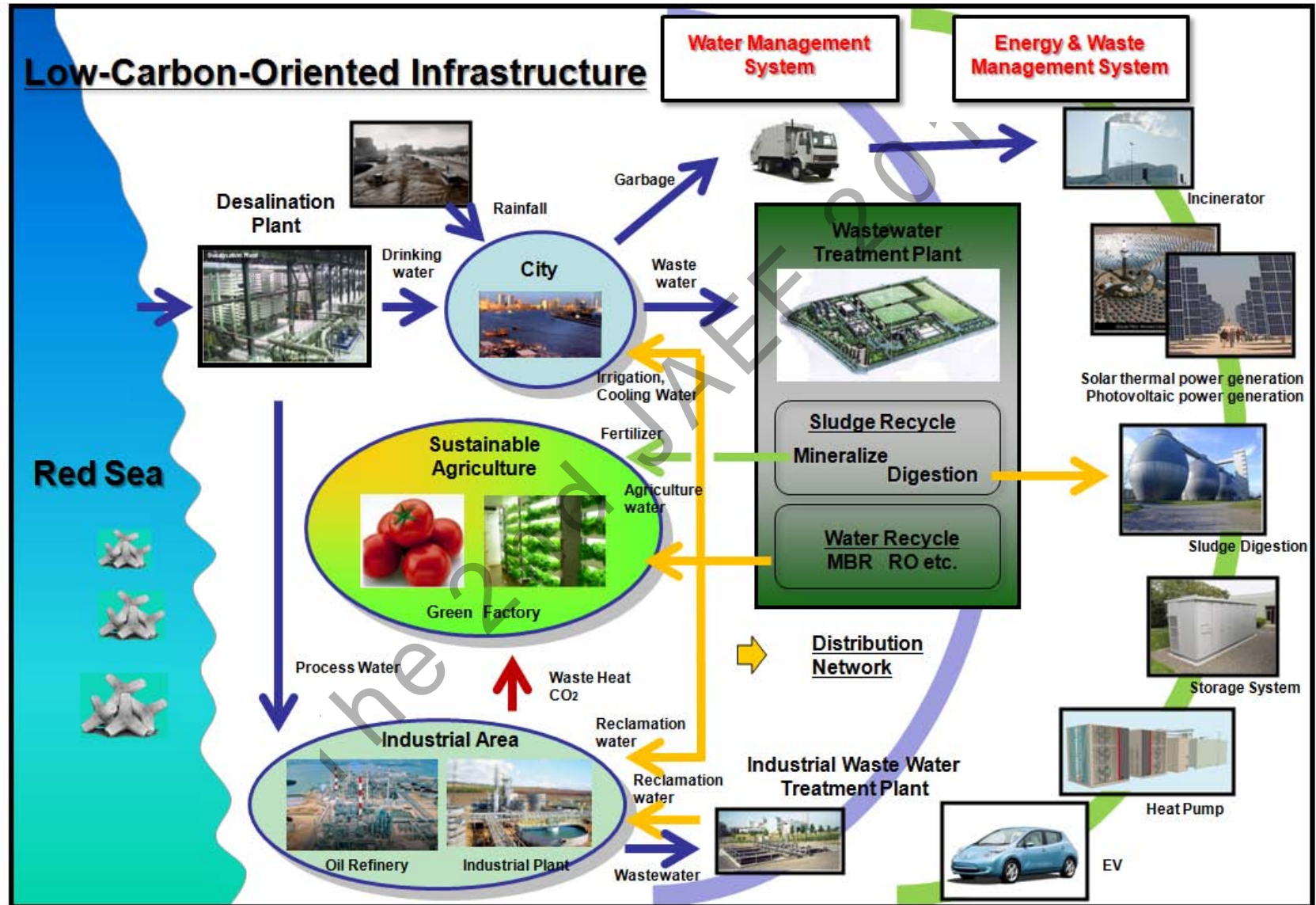
Japan Industrial Structure Vision 2010
