

Visit of the Governor of SWCC, KSA to Japan - Field Inspection for Introducing Japanese Advanced Technologies and "SWCC Water Symposium" -

November 7, 2023

JCCME invited a delegation of 16 members from **the Saline Water Conversion Corporation (SWCC)**, a Saudi governmental institution, headed by H.E. Abdullah Al Abdulkarim, the Governor of the SWCC, for four days from September 19 to 22, 2023 in Japan.

During their visit, they made inspection visits to the research facilities and factories of three Japanese companies in Nagasaki and Osaka, where they were introduced to Japan's cutting-edge technologies, expertise and products.

Subsequently, **"the SWCC Water Symposium"** was held in Tokyo, where the Governor made key note speech on the current status of seawater desalination industry in Saudi Arabia, followed by lively exchanges of views on the topics of Future Innovation and the Supply Chains between the participating Japanese companies/universities/research institutions and SWCC.

In addition, **B2B meetings** between the SWCC and Japanese companies/universities/ research institutions were hold.

Further, a **Letter of Cooperation** was exchanged between the SWCC and JCCME to further strengthen the current collaboration in the desalination water business. It is particularly worth noting that JCCME has been collaborating with the SWCC for many years and has continued to host webinars on the seawater desalination technology, even during the COVID-19 pandemic.
