

Report on the Graduation Ceremony for the 4th and 5th Batch of Trainees of Saudi Electronics and Home Appliances Institute (SEHAI)

On 11th May 2014, under the patronage of H.H. Prince Ahmed bin Abdullah bin Abdulrahman Al-Saud, Governor of Dir'iyah, SEHAI hosted the Graduation Ceremony for trainees of the 4th and 5th batches, totaling 107, at its campus in Dir'iyah, about 20 km northwest of the center of Riyadh.
