Contents | During 19-25 February 2014, in Tokyo, JCCME offered a training course for SEHAI (Saudi Electronics & Home Appliances Institute) managers. SEHAI is a two-year vocational training institute established in Riyadh, capital of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, in September 2009, and has already produced 219 graduates. In this training course, Mr. Fahad Suleiman Al Harbi, Executive Director of SEHAI, and Mr. Musaed Saad Al Otaibi, Administration Manager of SEHAI, participated in the program organized by OVTA (Overseas Vocational Training Association).

Result Achievement | This training course was prepared aiming to develop management skills of SEHAI managers for SEHAI's self-reliant operation of "Japan Course," technology class Japanese government has supported, and offered lectures with several themes: role of managers of vocational institute, teaching method of educational training, safety management of vocational institute and action plan of management of student residence. In addition, Mr. Al Harbi and Mr. Al Otaibi attended a class of Japanese cultures, in order to develop their awareness about the uniqueness of "Japan Course." Besides the lectures, Mr. Al Harbi and Mr. Al Otaibi visited Tokyo Metropolitan Vocational Skills Development Center (Akabane school), which prepared similar technical curriculum of SEHAI. Also, Mr. Al Harbi participated in the 14th Saudi Arabia-Japan Business Council, held on 18th February, and attended the ceremony of donation of teaching materials by Katayanagi Institute to SEHAI. On this occasion, he gave a speech, expressing his appreciation for Japan's support for SEHAI and importance of this collaborative relationship between two countries.
